- Career-FIT is a **post-doctoral fellowship programme**, part-funded by Horizon 2020 (Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - COFUND), and part-funded by [Enterprise Ireland](#).
- A key feature of Career-FIT is the opportunity for experienced researchers from outside Ireland to develop their careers in **market-focused applied research** through three-year fellowships with secondments in industry.
- Successful candidates will carry out research in Ireland and will gain **intersectoral** and **interdisciplinary** exposure through the programme, which will include a 6-12 month secondment in industry.
- Awarded Fellowships will commence around 30 September 2017 and run for three years.
